

Volunteers needed for mission team Jan. 27- Feb. 3, 2018 to South Florida

The team will be about 10 members, and will be staying at a Boy Scout facility in the Keys: Brinton Environmental Center, 23800 Overseas Hwy, Summerland Key, FL.

The facility provides bunks with mattresses, bed linens (I think this includes blankets) and pillows. They will serve us breakfast and dinner each morning / evening.

The facility has showers hot (warm?) water

Overview of the week:

Arriving Miami International Airport (MIA) the afternoon of Saturday January 27th and driving (~3 hours) to the mission site.

Team members need to make their own travel arrangements. Team members need to arrive MIA around 5:00 PM on Jan 27th. If you can't arrive until Sunday, please let me know and we may be able to make other transportation arrangements

Sunday will be local worship and down time.

Monday – Friday will be work days. Will probably take a 1/2 day off mid-week and wrap up early Friday afternoon to return to the Brinton Center & pack up before dinner.

Work could range from clearing out damage to clean up to actual restoration (e.g., hanging drywall).

Departing after dinner on Friday February 2nd and stay at a Courtyard (by Marriott) about 15 miles from MIA so we can catch morning flights home from MIA on Saturday the 2nd.
